Program:

The workshop will cover all aspects of number fields and function fields, including algebraic groups over such fields. It is conceived for bringing together graduate students, postdocs, and more experienced researchers working in the area.

The workshop will start on Sunday afternoon, May 7, and end on Thursday afternoon, May 11. Morning is planned for minicourses and 1-hour survey talks, and late afternoon for shorter communications. Long afternoon break is reserved for non-formal discussions. On Tuesday, May 9, a trip around Galilee is planned.

This workshop is part of the activities of the French-Israeli program of cooperation between Institute of Mathematics of Luminy, Poncelet French-Russian Mathematics Laboratory and Bar-Ilan University, supported by the Ministry of Education and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (France), and the Ministry of Science and Technology (Israel).

Accommodation:

The workshop will take place in Carlton hotel in Nahariya (Western Galilee). The special conference rate is 50 euro per night on the half-board basis for a person in a double room (for a 4-night stay from May 7 to May 11). Single accommodation will cost 15 euro more. For earlier arrivals, the night from May 5 to May 6 is 7 euro more expensive. Booking should be made by filling the registration form below (and not by direct contact with the hotel).

Location and arrival:

The venue of the workshop, Nahariya, is a small resort town in the north of Israel on the shores of the Mediterranean Sea). The weather during the month of May is warm

and dry. Air and water temperatures allow one pleasant beach activities. Nahariya has convenient railway connection to the Ben-Gurion International airport (2 hours by direct train) and most Israeli cities, see the timetable at <http://www.israrail.org.il>. All major attractions of the northern part of Israel are within easy drive. On planning your trip, please pay attention on the special timetable on Fridays and Saturdays.
